## VOTING IN MISSISSIPPI WITH A CRIMINAL CONVICTION

- In Mississippi, only 22 crimes take away right to vote away (all for life), and only if the conviction was in a MS state court.



### **VOTER ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

YOU CAN VOTE IF ALL FOUR STATEMENTS ARE TRUE FOR YOU

- 1. You are a U.S. citizen and will be at least 18 years old by the date of the next election.
- 2. You have not been declared mentally incompetent by a court.
- 3. You have never been convicted in a Mississippi state court of any of Mississippi's 22 "disenfranchising" offenses (and the felony version of it).
  - It's a felony to register to vote or vote if one is ineligible due to conviction of a disenfranchising offense.
- 4. You have been a resident of Mississippi and of a county, city, or town (your "residence") for at least 30 days.

# MISSISSIPPI MAIL-IN VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATION

- You can use this form to: register to vote in Mississippi or change your name and/or address. If you are registering for the first time in Mississippi and DO NOT have a Mississippi driver's license or social security number, you must send with this application a copy of a current and valid photo ID or a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or other government document that shows your name and address in
- An application for voter registration must be postmarked or hand delivered to the Circuit Clerk's Office located in the county of your voting residence no later than 30 days before an election.

  You may not register to vote if you have been convicted in a Mississippi state court of any of the following crimes: voter fraud, murder, rape, bribery, theft, arson, obtaining money or goods under false pretense, perjury, forgery, embezzlement, bigamy, armed robbery, extortion, felony bad check, felony shoplifting, larceny, receiving stolen property, robbery, timber larceny, unlawful taking of a motor vehicle, statutory rape, carjacking or larceny under lease or rental agreement.
- If you live in an area without house numbers or street names, please include a drawing of your location to enable us to identify your appropriate voting precinct.

  Photo ID Required to Vote: You will be required to present an acceptable form of photo identification when you vote at your polling place on Election Day or by absentee ballot in your Circuit Clerk's Office, unless exempted by law.
